Dauphin Island on **Thursday, June 9**. The bus will depart the Nix Center at 8:30 a.m. and return mid-to-late afternoon. Space is limited to the first 15 members who sign up. Please sign up in advance. Those that are unable to ride the bus are welcome to drive their own cars and meet the group on Dauphin Island at Fort Gaines.
