The City Council, City of Fairhope, met in regular session at 6:00 p.m., Fairhope Municipal Complex Council Chamber, 161 North Section Street, Fairhope, Alabama 36532, on Monday, 25 July 2016.

Present were Council President Jack Burrell, Councilmembers: Rich Mueller and Kevin Boone, Mayor Timothy M. Kant, Attorney Marcus McDowell, and City Clerk Lisa A. Hanks. Councilmembers: Diana Brewer and Michael A. Ford, and City Attorney Marion E. Wynne were absent.

There being a quorum present, Council President Burrell called the meeting to order. The invocation was given by Lead Pastor Johnny Hunt of Celebration Church, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Council President Burrell paid tribute to the Fairhope National Ozone Rookie team who won the State Championship in Oxford Alabama. He asked for Head Coach Brad Conway, Coach Brad Hatcher, and Coach Bryan Moseley to come up front with the team. The team members in attendance were Jacob Conway, Jackson Hatcher, Ben Moseley, Brooks Brasfield, Landon Phipps, John Wesley Noble, Maddox Davis, Briggs Acton, Kenny Yeend, DJ Harris, Ashton Maloney, and Chris Garrett.

Councilmember Boone moved to approve minutes of the 11 July 2016, regular meeting; minutes of the 11 July 2016, work session; and minutes of the 11 July 2016, agenda meeting. Seconded by Councilmember Mueller, motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Council President Burrell stated there was a need to add on an agenda item after Agenda Item Number 17: a Resolution that Resolutions No. 2559-16 and No. 2560-16 be and are hereby rescinded; relating to the Fly Creek Marina Improvements (Bid No. 024-16 and PS012-16).

Councilmember Boone moved to add on the above mentioned item **not** on the printed agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Mueller. Attorney McDowell read the proposed resolution to be added to the agenda. After further discussion, motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Mayor Kant addressed the City Council regarding the following items:

1. Chief Petties to come forward. Chief Petties announced the Back to School Picnic which will be held on Saturday, August 6, 2016 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Fairhope Rotary Youth Club. He said there will be a dunking booth and invited the City Council and Mayor to participate.

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He also mentioned a book bag giveaway. This will be a community activity and want everyone to be involved.

2. The paving of the roundabout at County Road 13 and Fairhope Avenue has begun; and it is scheduled to open on August 2, 2016.

Council President Burrell addressed the City Council and requested for Community Affairs and Recreation Director Sherry Sullivan to give an update on the Manley Road Soccer Complex. Ms. Sullivan said the nine fields are grassed, fencing is almost complete, and the paving done. She also mentioned the concession stand and restrooms with partial funding by the Fairhope Single Tax Corporation. The annual Halloween Tournament is still scheduled in October and to be played at the Soccer Complex. She commented the Soccer League will pay for goals, equipment, and benches. She also said that there is landscape to be done on Manley Road and in the parking areas.

Councilmember Boone introduced in writing, and moved for the adoption of the following resolution, a resolution to Appoint Election Officials for Election Day 23 August 2016, and Run-off Election Day 4 October 2016, if necessary. Seconded by Councilmember Mueller, motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Fairhope, Alabama that the election Officers for said elections shall be as follow:



Council President Burrell stated that Agenda Item No. 12 was pulled at the request of the Electric Superintendent Jimmy Cluster.





The following individual addressed the City Council during Public Participation for Non-Agenda Items:

1. Erik Cortinas, citizen of Fairhope, addressed the City Council regarding Sunday Night Lights sponsored by the First Baptist Church is scheduled for August 7, 2016 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Faulkner Amphitheatre.
2. Sandra Woodrow, 399 South Ingleside, addressed the City Council regarding the traffic at the 4-way stop not stopping. She also mentioned large trucks coming down Ingleside and concerns about new street being damaged. The haunted Halloween House was another concern due to noise, especially after 10:00 p.m.

Mayor Kant said he would get with Chief Petties on issues and possibly sending this to the Street and Traffic Control Committee. He said the noise after 10:00 p.m. will have to be addressed.
