

Handicap System

The purpose of the USGA Handicap System is to make the game of golf more enjoyable by enabling players of different abilities to compete on an equitable basis.

Two basic premises underlie the USGA Handicap System, namely that each player will try to make the best score at every hole in every round, regardless of where the round is played and that the player will post every round for peer review.

Currently at Quail Creek, individuals other than the player, are posting 10,000 handicap scores per year. These rounds should be posted by the players as outlined in the USGA Handicap rules.

With the transfer to the GHIN Handicap System it is requested that each player post his/her own rounds into the GHIN Handicap System. This includes all league play and friendly games with your buddies. With the GHIN Handicap app, you can download it and easily post your handicap scores.
