Under supervision of the Lineman Class A and the Assistant Superintendent, performs skilled electrical work in the construction, maintenance and operation of the City's electrical transmission and distribution system, both overhead and underground.

- Installs, maintains, and operates the electrical system facilities, including distribution system, substation, and street lights.
- Operates utility vehicles, including boom trucks, Derrick trucks, service trucks, etc.
- Installs and maintains utility poles, involving setting, framing and installing hardware, guys and other related materials.
- Installs and removes transformers capacitors, switches, conductors, and other similar equipment.
- Installs and maintains underground conductors, transformers, elbows, terminators, splices, and secondary voltage conductors and connections.
- Performs rubber glove work on high voltage lines.
- Removal of dead or damaged trees.
- Hanging seasonal lights.
- Climbing water towers.
