

RULES AND CODE OF CONDUCT

It is the intent of the City if Fairhope Recreation (FRC), to provide a safe and friendly environment for all members, volunteers and staff. We strive to have our members and staff exemplify an attitude of caring, responsibility, respect and honesty. Please join us as we provide for the physical well being of our members and our community by following our Rules and Code of Conduct.

- 1. Please present proof of membership upon entry to the facility. Allowing anyone to use the membership ID other than the individual named on it will result in temporary or permanent suspensions of all membership privileges. We reserve the right to request a picture ID if warranted.
- 2. All persons using the facility or grounds are expected to follow all FRC policies and procedures and to conduct themselves appropriately. Physical or verbal abuse, sexual innuendo or display of offensive behavior of any kind is considered unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
- 3. Modesty and personal values are as varied as the members of the FRC. Please be discrete and modest as possible when using the shower facilities.
- 4. The FRC is a smoke, drug and alcohol free facility. This also includes the grounds. The possession or sale of any illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia will lead to prosecution to the fullest extent of the law and suspension of all member privileges.
- 5. Children ages 13 and younger are to be supervised at all times by a parent or responsible adult (18 years or older), unless participating in a staff supervised program.
- 6. Please wear appropriate gym, swim and workout attire. Street shoes are not permitted on the gym floor, court surfaces or fitness equipment. Open-toed shoes/sandals are not permitted in the exercise areas. Eye protection must be worn for racquetball.
- 7. The FRC is not responsible for any items stolen in the facility or grounds. Please secure your personal belongings in a safe manner while in the facility.
- 8. The FRC staff has the right to determine if any conduct or language is inconsistent with the rules of conduct and to act accordingly.
- 9. To protect families and children of the FRC, electronic devices containing cameras (cameras, cell phones, PDA's, etc.) are strictly forbidden in the changing areas.
