Position Description: General nature/purpose of work: This is responsible work in the operation and maintenance of a municipal sewage treatment plant and sewage collection facilities. **An employee of this class is responsible for the operation of sewage treatment plant on a designated shift of work. The employee operates the plant in accordance with established directives provided by a superior and work is done independently except in the case of unusual circumstances or emergency situations. Employee works under general supervision** of Water and Sewer Superintendent.

Primary Responsibilities Include:

Measures and records quantity and temperature of waste to plant	Performs routine repairs and maintenance to sewer treatment plant and related equipment;
Checks physical and chemical composition of sewage as required	Working knowledge of the operation of a sewage treatment plant
Collects samples of waste for laboratory analysis	Working knowledge of physical chemical testing methods and elementary laboratory procedures
Makes routine simple laboratory tests of sewage and waste	Performs necessary operations as required of directed in conjunction with electrical panel controls, electric, hydraulic or mechanical valves, pumps or gates to insure proper operation of the settling, aeration and sludge digestion processes
Maintains records of tests, meter readings, temperatures and volumes	Performs routine repairs and maintenance to sewer treatment plant and related equipment

Minimum Qualifications Standards: Graduation from a standard senior high school, or the successful completion of the General Educational Development (GED) test.

Special Requirements: Must possess a Grade 3 Waste water treatment operator Certificate issued by the State of Alabama; Must possess or be able to obtain a Commercial Driver’s License.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Working knowledge of the operation of a sewage treatment plant.
- Working knowledge of physical chemical testing methods and elementary laboratory procedures.
- Some knowledge of basic trades such as plumbing and electrical circuits.
- Ability to prepare and maintain records according to a prescribed format.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other employees and with the public.
