Position Description: General nature/purpose of work: The purpose of this position is to help in the maintenance of buildings, sidewalks, curbs, storm drains and other structures for the benefit of the City of Fairhope. A Carpenter II is responsible for performing a variety of skilled carpentry construction and maintenance activities. Work involves performance of carpentry tasks in the construction, alteration, and repair structures and equipment. Work is performed in accordance with accepted procedures for this trade under the general supervision of the Crew Leader for the City of Fairhope Streets and Construction Department.

Primary Responsibilities Include:
