Position Description: General nature/purpose of work: The purpose of this position is to work in the operation and maintenance of a municipal sewage treatment plant and sewage collection facilities. An Assistant Sewer Plant Operator is responsible for the operation of sewage treatment plant on a designated shift of work. The employee operates the plant in accordance with established directives provided by a superior and work is done independently except in the case of unusual circumstances or emergency situations. Employee works under general supervision of Water and Sewer Superintendent.

Minimum Qualifications Standards: Graduation from a standard senior high school, or the successful completion of the General Educational Development (GED) test.

Special Requirements: Must be able to obtain a minimum of Grade 2 waste treatment operator certification issued by the State of Alabama within three (3) years. Must possess or be able to obtain a Commercial Driver's License within 6 months of hire.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Working knowledge of the operation of a sewage treatment plant.

Working knowledge of physical chemical testing methods and elementary laboratory procedures.

Some knowledge of basic trades such as plumbing and electrical circuits.

Ability to prepare and maintain records according to a prescribed format.
