

The City Council, City of Fairhope, met in Special City Council meeting at 10:00 a.m., Fairhope Municipal Complex Council Chamber, 161 North Section Street, Fairhope, Alabama 36532, on Tuesday, 13 November 2018.

Present were Council President Jack Burrell, Councilmembers: Jay Robinson, Robert Brown, and Kevin Boone, City Attorney Marcus E. McDowell, and City Clerk Lisa A. Hanks. Mayor Karin Wilson and Councilmember Jimmy Conyers were absent.

There being a quorum present, Council President Burrell called the meeting to order. The invocation was given by Councilmember Kevin Boone and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Council President Burrell explained the reason for the meeting was to canvass the November 6, 2018 Special Municipal Election results.

City Clerk Lisa Hanks explained that the provisional ballots must be opened and counted at this meeting. City Clerk Hanks stated for the record that 66 provisional ballots were sent to the Board of Registrars and 16 were rejected which left 50 ballots accepted to be opened. City Clerk Lisa Hanks read the results of the provisional ballots to the City Council and stated one ballot was blank.

Council President Burrell read the resolution to certify the November 6, 20168 election announcing the results for the Council-Manager Form of Government referendum.

Councilmember Boone introduced in writing, and moved for the adoption of the following resolution, a resolution to Canvass the 2018 Special Municipal Election. Seconded by Councilmember Brown, motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

WHEREAS, the said municipal governing body has ascertained and determined the result of said election as follows:


