

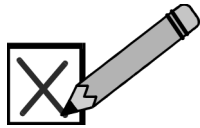
Arts & Crafts Festival

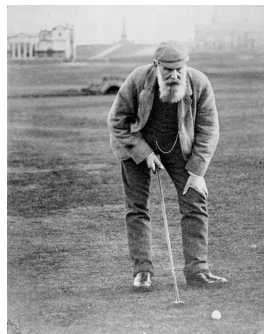

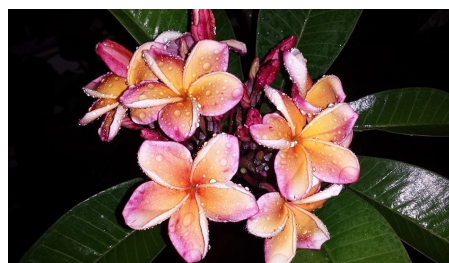
