Skip Jones requested Lynn Maser to introduce Sean Saye, Fairhope Docks Harbor Manager. Lynn provided an update to future plans at the Fairhope Docks. Lynn stated that any improvements made to existing buildings would have to meet current Building Code standards. She stated that there is a need in our area for dry storage. Lynn also stated she has two meeting scheduled for prospective Boat Yard operators. Lynn Maser asked the Board to put together a presentation to Council of which option would be best.

Channel dredging bid and basin dredging proposal is currently been worked on. The city has an agreement with the Fairhope Yacht Club for the dredging of the Channel from the flashing signal to the breaker boards. The board discussed federal permits needed for dredging

Scott Douglass made a motion to call a special called meeting monthly for the next six months, seconded by Bob Riggs; none opposed. The next scheduled meeting will be held November 14, 2018 at 4:30pm in the Delchamps Room.
