FAIRHOPE, Alabama – The City of Fairhope is moving forward with work on two major RESTORE grants that will make a difference for generations to come in the community. The Fairhope Sewer Upgrade Phase I and the Fairhope Area Community-Based Comprehensive Land Use Plan were both awarded in April 2020.

The evaluation and selection process for the \$10 million Sewer Upgrade is underway now. The three-step process will culminate in an engineering firm suggestion being made to the Fairhope City Council during the September 14th City Council meeting.

The \$650,000 Comprehensive Land Use Plan is out for bid at this time. The evaluation and selection timeline allows for engineering firm suggestions to be made to the Fairhope City Council by mid-October.

Both of these grants were applied for in 2017.
