Tree Committee Meeting

New Business:

Skip stated that the tree committee would reevaluate the tree after an official report from a certified arborist is completed.

Old Business:

Paige Crawford stated that due to COVID-19 the City of Fairhope would provide a drive through seedling give away this year at the Fairhope Civic Center, and Paul Merchant would work with his staff to package the seedlings. Also, a proclamation for Arbor Day and the beautification awards will be given out during an upcoming council meeting. There was general discussion among the tree committee members and beautification awards were selected. (see attached award list)

A motion was made to recommend to the City Council the appointment of Knox McMurphy and May-Moss Parker to the Tree Committee, 1st motion by Craig Tappan and 2nd by Patrick Waldrop and unanimously carried.
