QUESTIONS:

1) Q: Will the city provide Tax Exemption to the awarded vendor?

A: Yes. The City of Fairhope at the request of the awarded vendor will apply for a sales and use tax certificate of exemption (Form STC-1) for each tax-exempt project. Contractors and subcontractors licensed by the State Licensing Board for General Contractors, must also apply per project to the Department of Revenue for a sales and use tax certificate of exemption (Form STC-1). Upon review and approval of the application, the Department of Revenue shall issue the applicant a Form STC-1 which shall be used by the certificate holder to claim the exemption when making qualifying tax-exempt purchases for the project listed on the certificate. This Certificate of Exemption will be limited to purchases which qualify for an exemption of sales and use taxes pursuant to [Rule No. 810-6-3-77](#).

2) Q: Will SHOREFLEX be allowed as an approved equal to FLEXAMAT for the Concrete Erosion Control Mat?

A: Yes, NRCS allows SHOREFLEX as an approved equal. However, the use of this approved equal brand shall meet or exceed the specifications of the Flex-a-Mat PLUS material called in the plans and contract documents. Flex-a-Mat PLUS is a four layer system whose specifications can be found on their website.

3) Q: Does the Concrete Erosion Control Mat price need to include any earth anchors?

A: Your price shall include the material and installation of the specified Concrete Erosion Control Mat (or approved equal), all earth anchors (U-anchors), mat-to-mat anchoring, trenching, overlapping, etc. per the manufacturers recommendations.

This document shall be signed, scanned and emailed back to the Engineer for proof of receipt. All signed addendum(s) shall be attached to the front cover of the sealed proposal.
