

Beaded Rope Classes at the Nix!!!

This lovely Spiral Rope is simple to learn! It can be used alone as a bracelet, longer as a necklace, as a beaded neck chain for a pendant, or attached to the sides of a beaded necklace to form the neck strap. This is a 2 Day class (October 6 and 13 -- 9:30-12:30)

*The First Day is for learning the basic stitch and completing a bracelet, including clasp.

*The Second Day is for making samples of several more variations of this spiral using various size and color combinations of seed beads and bugle beads.

*Students will provide their own supplies.

(October 20 and 27 -- 9:30-12:30) This is a different method than the one in the Spiral Rope class, but can also be used as a bracelet, longer as a necklace, as a chain for a pendant, or attached to a beaded necklace as a neck strap. It can even be used to make Beaded Tubular Beads and Earrings!!



The First Day is for learning "odd count" stitch, using an odd number of beads....the EASIER version

The Second Day is for learning "even count" stitch....a little more complex as it requires a "step up" from row to row.
