
- Assistant Public Works Director George Ladd addressed the City Council regarding Agenda Items No. 14 and No. 16; and to answer any of their questions. He mentioned the Lighting of the Trees and the Christmas Parade. The truck over budget and the custom doors for the Museum were questioned.
- Recreation Director Pat White addressed the City Council regarding the Rotary Youth Park Project and Outdoor Movie Night.
