# **Community Benefits of Preservation**

- Preserves regional history and culture, and enhances Civic Pride
- Increases property values
- Contributes to sustainable growth
- Green solution easier on landfills, materials reused
- Good for business, including job creation and historic tourism

## **Benefits to the Individual Property Owner**

- Cost Savings
- Grants for Hurricane Recovery
- Tax Incentives for renovation
- Lowest ad valorem tax rates (lowest annual property tax rate)
- Giving back to Community

## **Common Myth**

Property owner loses control over making changes to property --- **NOT TRUE!**Read about owners rights and freedoms here

#### State

- <u>Lowest possible annual Property Taxes</u> for business and residential use. Non-historic residential properties are taxed at twice the rate, and commercial properties at three times the rate.
- <u>Substantial Return on Rehabilitation costs</u>: 25% refundable credit for renovation of commercial and private properties

## Eligibility

- A) Property 60 years or older;
- B) Listed or eligible for the <u>National Register of Historic Places</u>
  OR
- C) Property owned continuously for 39 years

Documentation from the <u>Alabama Historic Committee</u> required to receive <u>ad valorem tax credit</u> or <u>rehabilitation refunds</u>

List of local Properties Earning Credits on file with FHPC: eligible by request

#### Federal

- Federal Tax Credit: 20 % income tax and qualifying Rehabilitation costs for businesses
- Tax Credits for Easements on Historic Properties residential and business
- Process: <u>begin with certification at the state level to enlist in the National Register of Historic Places</u>, then claim benefit with help of accountant and appropriate documentation

### County

<u>Baldwin County Historic Commission:</u> Supports Banners and Shields, and historic markers. Identifies historic properties, but does not offer any protections of historic properties
