Minutes of the Fairhope Recreation Board

The Fairhope Recreation Board met on Wednesday, April 20, 2022, at 5:15 p.m. in the Rec Center at 803 North Greeno Road.

Present: Charlie Langham, Charlie Williamson, Haden Giddings, Pat White, Cathy Hudson, Jack Burrell and Corey Martin. Absent: Lisa Atchley, Maurice Morrisette and Derek Thomas.

The meeting was called to order by Charlie Williamson at 5:15 p.m. The minutes of the April 20, 2022, meeting minutes were considered and approved on a motion by Haden Giddings, seconded by Charlie Langham, none opposed.

Guest: Scott Berry attended the meeting and asked the Rec Board to considered for the opening position on the Board.

Recreation Updates:

Pat White informed the Rec Board of the following projects: The indoor pool has a mysterious water leak, and we are searching for the source; FHS Baseball plays tonight vs Daphne in Area play; Met with the engineers on the track project and so far, the topography survey has been done and the engineers are getting the geo survey done now. As of now, we will have to re-route the water main line and move 2 of the light poles. Removing the existing 2 story building was also discussed as the best option at this point, due to space: The fencing surrounding the playground area and garden at Rotary Youth Park is now complete. We will be working to establish a parking area next to the basketball court and a driveway that connects to the existing parking lot. We are also working on improvements to the baseball field in the back; The annual spring soccer tournament is this Saturday and Sunday, and we are expecting roughly 107 teams from multiple states. Our Parks & Rec Staff will be running the concession stand and will be serving pulled pork, chicken salad, hamburgers, cheeseburgers, etc.

Charlie Langham made a motion to approve Scott Berry as the new Rec Board Member and Haden Giddings second the motion.

Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:54 p.m.
