Amy Foley called the meeting to order and minutes from the April meeting were approved with a correction of the date to be made.

Funding requests for the 2022-2023 school year were presented. Jon Cardwell submitted proposed spending for Fairhope High, noting that most items were unchanged from the previous year but added a driver education/health instructor that is needed due to growth in 10<sup>th</sup> grade enrollment and an agriscience instructor for a new department to teach animal, poultry and equine sciences. For Fairhope West Elementary, Julie Pierce modified her request slightly from the previous year, highlighting the need for a behavioral coach to assist teachers with behavioral plans. Carol Broughton presented the request for Fairhope East Elementary, focusing on personnel items now and will request funds for other items later. Funding request from Patrice Wolfe for J. Larry Newton School continues the personnel previously funded and adds a new STEM teacher who will work with students and teachers. Fairhope Middle anticipates presenting their request at the June meeting. All requests were approved, to be funded from 3-mill monies. See detail below; full requests are attached.


