The Junior City Council, City of Fairhope, met in regular session at 4:30.m., Fairhope Mayoral Chambers, 161 North Section St. Fairhope, AL 36532, on Wednesday, January 12th, 2022

1. Approval of Agenda:

The agenda was unanimously approved as distributed.

2. Approval of Minutes:

The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved as distributed.

3. Announcements:

-Work Session for Sidewalk Project Presentation is scheduled for January 24th, 2022 at 4:30pm in the Fairhope City Chambers, 161 North Section St. Fairhope AL 36532.

4. Open Issues:

-Sidewalk project and powerpoint presentation:

There was a recent meeting with Richard Johnson for the sidewalk project. In this meeting a four hundred and fifty dollar estimated budget was agreed upon. The city mentioned that they had some paint available, in the colors red, blue, yellow, and white, for the project but more would be needed for the project's completion. The Junior City Council was granted permission to mix paints for the project. Furthermore, the city workers would lay down a template of the crosswalk, consisting of a white outline of boxes. The city is requesting that the project be completed within one day to prevent issues with traffic. Project completion dates are still in question with March 5th, 2022 and March 12th, 2022 being the current potential dates.

- Community-Based Comprehensive Land Use Plan:

The meeting date is on January 26th, 2022 at 6:00pm inside of The Fairhope Highschool Library. The address is 1 Pirate Dr, Fairhope AL, 36532. The Junior City Council will facilitate discussion with attendees, and they will be responsible for bringing members of the community to attend the meeting. To encourage the youth of Fairhope to attend, The Junior City Council will talk to Fairhope High School to determine if clubs, such as Girls Service Club or Key Club, will count the meeting for club hours. Questions will be

related to the growth of Fairhope in the next ten to twenty years and concerns about returning to Fairhope after college.

5. New Business:

-Work Session for Sidewalk Presentation:

There will be five to ten minutes of speaking and presentation time. Questions from the City Council will not count into the speaking and presentation time. Council members Galey McKelvain and Joseph Soloman will be speaking and presenting the project during the work session. Other city council members are encouraged to attend to aid in answering questions from The City Council. Junior City Council members that will be in attendance for the work session will be required to look over the presentation for the sidewalk to prepare for any questions to be asked.
