Minutes of the Fairhope Recreation Board

The Fairhope Recreation Board met on Wednesday, August 17, 2022, at 5:15 p.m. in the Rec Center at 803 North Greeno Road.

Present: Lisa Atchley, Maurice Morrisette, Cathy Hudson, Jack Burrell, Corey Martin, Scott Berry; Absent: Pat White, Haden Giddings, Charlie Langham, Derek Thomas, and Dan Hoover.

The meeting was called to order by Lisa Atchley at 5:16 p.m. The minutes of the July 20, 2022, meeting minutes were considered and approved on a motion by Jack Burrell, seconded by Scott Berry, none opposed.

Recreation Updates:

Pat White's assistant, Becky Barnard informed the Rec Board that the finishing touches to the football stadium are in progress. That as of today, concrete is done, brickwork is nearing completion, fencing is going back up and sod is set to be delivered tomorrow (8/18/22); Parks and Rec Staff have gone above and beyond to make the stadium something we are extremely proud of; We are hosting St. Michael's football game against Gulf Shores tomorrow night (8/18/22) and Fairhope Pirates home game against Spanish Fort on Friday (8/19/22), both games to have large turnouts; Pat is meeting with the track engineer Friday morning (8/19/22) to review final plans for the track project and to discuss budgetary needs moving forward; Bathroom building for new field complex at Volanta is out for bids as well as the LED lighting installation. Once the light poles are installed, irrigation and sod will be done, and a bid for the fencing will go out for bid.

Recreation New Business:

There was general discussion about the possible real estate closing soon of the Quail Creek Pickleball courts and adjacent lot; Upon the closing of the sale, then bids can start going out on having those courts resurfaced; Electrical work has now begun at the Marina; General discussion about getting the new track budget narrowed down (some mention of roughly \$1.5 million for that project); General discussion about some open space in the future to possibly build 3 additional hotels in Fairhope, with 2 being in downtown and 1 being out by Walmart; Cathy Hudson stated that high school swim team teams started tryouts already and that they are looking forward to a great season.

Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:07 p.m.
