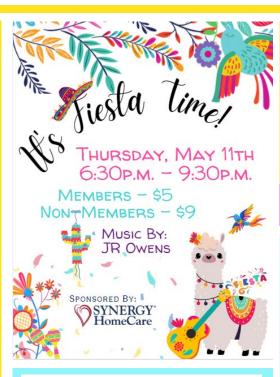

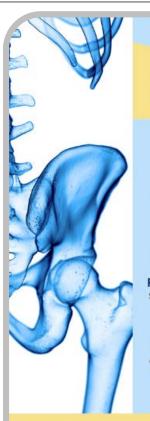

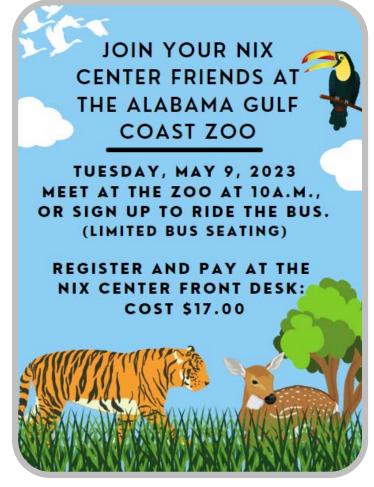

with Sarah Blizzard Robinson Tuesday, May 23 10:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

With multiple ways to go about the selfpublishing business, Sarah shares her experience, and the ways to bring your story to life and successfully market your book.

Sarah Blizzard Robinson is the author of the memoir, As a Result. A cautionary tale, the coming-of-age, marriage and recovery stories are woven together from the author's depth of experience, offering hope to generations of families dealing with the effects of alcoholism, grief and codependency.

The author has called the Gulf Coast home off and on for many years, and she and her husband recently joined the throngs of people moving to Fairhope, Alabama. Her essays, short stories, poems and profile articles appear in newspapers, literary journals, magazines and anthologies. A graduate of Caron Foundations' recovery program, the author has been sober and grateful since 1986. In her book talks, Sarah highlights the importance of telling our stories.

Robinson gives book talks to recovery groups, women's groups, and book clubs. She teaches workshops on Memoir and Creative Writing, as well as Self-Publishing. Her writings have won awards and been published since 2009 in the following formats: Outside Bozeman Magazine, WV Living Magazine, Morgantown Living, and Heartwood Literary Magazine.

Sarah's had numerous poems published in Pittsburgh's Carlow University's Voices from the Attic anthologies. Sarah's most recent publications include poems in Ohio's Appalachian Voices: I Thought I Heard a Cardinal Sing.

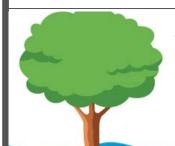
