

City Landfill Drop Off – Updated Policies – Effective 06/01/2023

CODE OF ORDINANCES City of FAIRHOPE, ALABAMA: Sec. 21-77.1. - Public works director's authority.

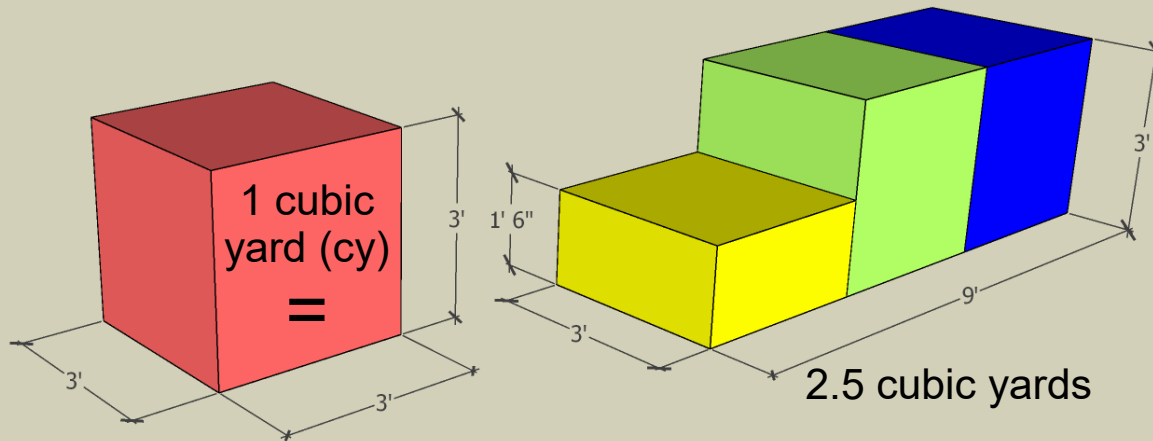
The public works director has the authority to set certain policies and procedures. These policies and procedures include, but are not limited to, use of the city landfill and city dump, rates for picking up excessive quantities of trash, appliances, or garbage, tires or other disposed items, special pick-ups in alleyways where automated garbage trucks are not accessible, placement of garbage and trash items on right-of-way, or other items as is necessary. (Ord. No. 1296, 3-9-06)

The City of Fairhope's landfill is not an infinite resource. Our current ADEM Solid Waste Disposal Facility Permit (02-07) expires April 6, 2030. At the current volumes of incoming solid waste there is a possibility that there will be no further renewal due to maximum landfill capacity being reached. In an effort to maximize future capacity and clarify the allowable uses the following Landfill Drop Off policies will take effect on June 1, 2023:

- Landfill Hours of Operations:** Monday – Friday: 7:00am - 3:00pm
Saturday: 7:00am to Noon
Sunday & City Holidays: Closed
- Accepted Solid Waste:** Construction Debris / Junk Items / Green Waste
- Limits on Volume:** Maximum 2.5 Cubic Yards (Per Customer/Per Day) – See attached flyer
- Disallowed Materials:** Treated Lumber
Wire or Chain Link Fencing
No Commercial Items / Debris
Tires
Any Other Identified Hazardous Waste
- Household Hazardous Waste:** Paint / Electronics / Chemicals / Motor Oil / Insecticides
- Accepted Only On:** Once a Quarter: 1st Saturday of the following Months:
February / May / August / November
- Limit on Paint Disposal:** 5 Gallon Limit Per Account (Quarterly on above dates, Original Containers Only)

Visual Representation of two and a half (2-1/2) Cubic Yards



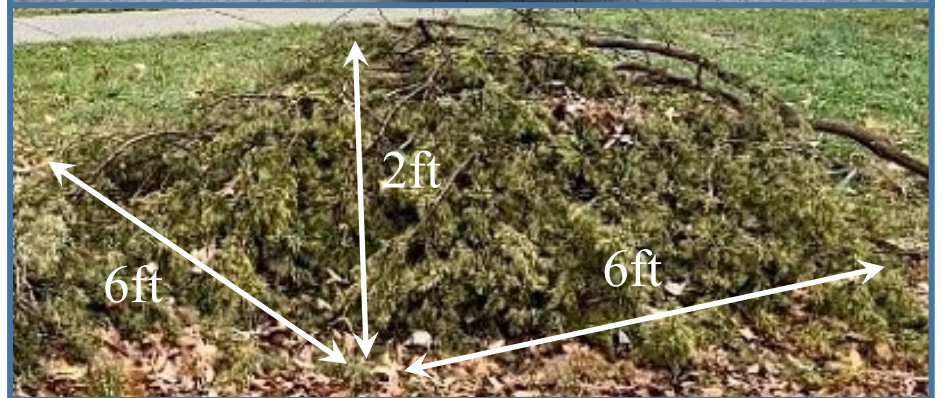
The bed of a full size standard pickup has dimensions of: 8' long X 5.33' wide X 1.5' high. When loaded level full, a truck of this size will hold 2.5 cubic yards of material.



Twelve (12) 30-gallon trash bags filled full = 2.5 cubic yards



A limb/trash pile 6 ft wide x 6 ft deep x 2 ft high = 2.5 cubic yards





LANDFILL DROP OFF RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR VOLUME & QUANTITIES

- Construction Debris / Junk Items / Green Waste:
 - Limited to 2.5 Cubic Yards (Per Customer/Per Day)
 - No Treated Lumber
 - No Wire or Chain Link Fencing
 - No Commercial Items / Debris
- Tires: NO DISPOSAL
- Paint / Electronics / Chemicals / Motor Oil / Insecticides (Household Items Only)
 - These Items Only accepted Quarterly: 1st Saturday of the following Months: February / May / August / November
- Paint - 5 Gallon Limit Per Account (Quarterly on above dates, Original Containers Only)
- **NO RUMMAGING OR PILFERING THROUGH CITY WASTE**

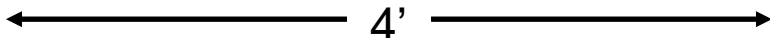
