The parade will be on November 4 at 10 a.m. and will begin and end at the Fairhope Civic Center. The parade provides the public with the opportunity to salute and honor our local veteran community. Leading the parade will be Fairhope's 2023 Veteran of the Year.

The celebration will continue Saturday, November 11, at 4:45 p.m. in Henry George Park. A sunset prayer service will be held at Tears of Sorrow, Tears of Joy, the City's veterans memorial. Pastor Mike Megginson with 3 Circle Church will lead the prayer service and Taps will be performed following the prayer.
