The City Council, City of Fairhope, met in regular session at 6:00 p.m., Fairhope Municipal Complex Council Chamber, 161 North Section Street, Fairhope, Alabama 36532, on Monday, 26 August 2013.

Present were Council President Jack Burrell, Councilmembers: Rich Mueller, Diana Brewer, Michael A. Ford, and Kevin Boone, Mayor Timothy M. Kant, City Attorney Marion E. Wynne, and City Clerk Lisa A. Hanks.

There being a quorum present, Council President Burrell called the meeting to order. The invocation was given by Reverend Michael Davis, from Twin Beech AME Zion Church, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Council President Burrell stated there was a need to add on an agenda item after Agenda Item Number 15; a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss Pending Litigation.

Councilmember Boone moved to add on the above mentioned item **not** on the printed agenda. Seconded by Councilmember Ford, motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

Councilmember Brewer moved to approve minutes of the 12 August 2013, regular meeting; minutes of the 12 August 2013, work session; and minutes of the 12 August 2013, agenda meeting. Seconded by Councilmember Mueller, motion passed by the following voice votes: AYE – Mueller, Brewer, Ford, and Boone. NAY – None. ABSTAIN – Burrell.

Mayor Kant addressed the City Council regarding the following items:

- 3) Received Bids for the new sewer plant upgrades and would like for the Engineer of Record to present at the beginning of the September 10, 2013 meeting; and
- 4) Wednesday went to Demopolis and spoke on Downtown Revitalization at the request of Mayor Michael Grayson.

Councilmember Boone addressed the City Council regarding the City of Fairhope Veteran of the Year nominations and stated the form for nominees are at the front desk at City Hall.

26 August 2013
