Fairhope Tree Committee & Wisteria Garden Club Treasured Tree Program

The Fairhope Tree Committee and the Wisteria Garden Club invite Fairhope property owners to nominate their trees for inclusion in Fairhope's Treasured Trees Program. The program aims to recognize private property owners in the city who protect the large trees, which contribute greatly to Fairhope's beautiful landscape. Trees recognized as a Treasured Tree are still the responsibility of the homeowner and are not regulated in anyway by the City of Fairhope or the Wisteria Garden Club. The sponsors will record pertinent information and supply a program certificate to the owners for each tree meeting the criteria listed below. Additionally, the sponsors will provide a plaque or sign identifying the largest specimen of each tree species nominated and will be recognized on Arbor Day.

Criteria for Fairhope's Treasured Trees are as follows:

A person may nominate only trees on their own property.

*Oak trees must have trunks at 125 inches in circumference or to 40 inches in diameter, at 4 ½ feet above the ground . Other tree species must have 70% of the point value of the current Alabama State Champion. Point values are determined by using the National Big Tree formula of "circumference in inches at 4 ½ feet, height in feet, one quarter of the crown spread in feet". Example: "A tree is 60" in circumference, 50" in height and 40' in crown spread" --- 60 + 50 + 10 = 120 pts.---- Estimates of measurements are welcome. Current list of state champions may be viewed on the Alabama Forestry Commission website.

*Trees must be in reasonably good healthy and expected to survive 10 years or longer to be nominated.

*Representatives from the Fairhope Tree Committee will examine and measure each tree nominated to make sure the tree meets all the criteria.
