Fall-Proofing Your Home

Bedroom

- Place a lamp and phone close to your bed where they are easy to reach
- Sleep on a bed that's easy to get in & out of
- Use a night light so you can see where you're walking

Living Area

- Arrange furniture with clear pathways
- Remove area rugs or use nonslop backing tape so rugs stay put
- Keep electrical cords out of walkway
- Sit on furniture that is easy to get up from
- Install light switches at the entrance of rooms
- Remove clutter from pathways

Bathroom

- Use slip resistant rugs near the bathtub
- Use rubber mats or textured strips in the tub or shower
- Install grab bars inside the tub and next to the toilet
