Re: City of Fairhope Pole Banner Policy

Fairhope civic organizations and Fairhope not-for-profit organizations are eligible to hang pole banners in the City of Fairhope. The pole banners may be hung as a privilege to Fairhope based organizations that are hosting public and charitable events. Banners are hung by the City of Fairhope Electric Department at no charge to the organization.

Banners shall be double-sided, 36" wide and 86" tall. A rod pocket shall be placed on the top of the banner. The rod pocket shall be no less than 3" long (to accommodate a 1.5" diameter rod). Pockets that are sewn rather than glued in place are preferred. Four grommets shall be evenly placed across the bottom of the banner. Banners shall be dropped off at least one week before the date they need to be hung at the City of Fairhope Warehouse (555 South Section Street).

No more than three banners may be hung per event providing space is available. The City of Fairhope will do their best to accommodate requested locations but does NOT guarantee locations. Banners can be hung two weeks before a scheduled event and may not contain any advertising. The City of Fairhope reserves the right to deny any pole banner request.

Banners must be picked up one week after the event date. Banners left at the City Warehouse are not the responsibility of the City and may be discarded.
