Old Business-Hubert Hinote reported on Ala Code 115486-This report included the history of our IDB which was established in 1965. The board will have 7 members with 6 year terms. In the code was a reference to the board being called "Commercial Development Authority of the City of Fairhope" There was some discussion about having the name officially changed to this as we felt that it better reflected the purpose of our board. Jack Burrell was to contact the City Attorney about have the Board's name changed.
