Council President Burrell called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

The following request was on the agenda: Speed Calming Devices on Morphy Avenue. Jonathan Smith stated that Shane Bergen with Neel-Schaffer explained that in order for stop signs to be placed at the Morphy and Church intersection; there needs to be 300 trips during peak hours on Morphy and 200 trips during peak hours on Church. Jennifer Fidler explained the requests. Mayor Kant stated a speed hump was needed for the correct speak between both parks.

Mayor Kant moved to recommend from the City Council authorization to place two speed calming devices on Morphy Avenue to help with traffic, especially near the parks. The recommended type would slow traffic to 15 mile per hour. Seconded by Council President Burrell, motion passed unanimously by voice vote.


