**Questions from potential bidders:**

**Question 1:** If there are more than 8-10 talks paths could you do 6.25 mhz?

**Answer 1:**  
**We will consider solutions that operate at 6.25Mhz.**

**Question 2:**  
Do you want new consoles?

**Answer 2:**  
Yes, ours are 9+ years old

**Question 3:**  
How many talk-around channels do you need? Radio to Radio?

**Answer 3:**  
We need 6 Simplex –non repeater: Command, SWAT, Public works, Water System, Gas, Electric. These simplex channels will be used without accessing the repeater, and are simply for hand-held to hand-held communication at any particular scene.

**Question 4:**  
Is there information available that would shed light on whether the City of Fairhope could put radio equipment on these towers at no charge to the City?

**Answer 4:**  
The City does own five water towers located around town that may have room to facilitate additional tower sites. Any access or attachment to these towers would be free-of-charge, but subject to permission by the Water Superintendent and his requirements.

**Question 5:**  
It was stated in the pre-bid meeting today that testing had been done and the coverage areas required could be covered with a 2 tower solution. What towers were used in the testing, and are these accessible by the City at no charge?

**Answer 5:**

Testing has been performed with repeaters on the Fairhope Avenue (Wal-mart) water tank, and the Nichols Street water tank. These would both be accessible by the city free-of-charge, but subject to permission by the Water Superintendent and his requirements.
